Why we are here ...

Paul aged 7 and Susan aged 5 lived on the streets of Kiambu, a small town, 23km north of Nairobi in Kenya. Every day they would search for food and shelter. With their mother in police custody and with no state support they were left to fend for themselves.

In June 1998 David Hinga noticed Paul and Susan come into his church. He was so moved by their circumstances that he and his wife Alice took them into their home until their own mother was able to take care of them.



Today, Paul and Susan are healthy, well and have started their education at Tumaini. Many children in Kiambu go hungry and cannot afford to go to school. This further deepens the cycle of poverty for future generations.

Many children did not attend school because they needed to look after younger siblings whilst their mothers worked on the coffee estates.

The Tumaini Brooks Centre provides childcare for children under three so that older siblings can attend school to improve their prospects and broaden their view of life.
